Introduction

FEJS received £8885 Sport Premium (2015-16). We aim to increase participation and opportunity to take part in/try new sports.

Uses of the funding from September 2015-16:

- Extra PE lesson each week for pupils identified as more able in PE (Year 5 and 6)
- Specialist Sports Coach to deliver extra lunchtime clubs. Different sports and year groups will be rotated to maximise opportunity and participation.
- Specialist Sports Coach to deliver extra training sessions for teams competing in tournaments
- After school clubs such as Dance, Hockey, Football and Multi-sports
- Lunchtime Running and Athletics Club
- Additional non-contact time for PE leader/Sports Coach to work alongside sports coach and teachers to improve the quality of teaching and learning in PE.
- Partnership Fees to enable participation in tournaments, Dance Festival etc within the cluster.
